

Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on

June 27, 1995

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Englewood met in called session, Tuesday, June 27, 1995, at 7:00 p.m. in the Assembly Room at City Hall.

The Mayor called the meeting to order with Commissioners Davis, Long, Brock, and Middleton present. Invocation was given by Davis.

A group of citizens were present wishing to discuss the Hwy 411 project. Mayor Cass informed those present that notices for the meeting were posted on the previous Thursday afternoon with only the 3rd reading of the fiscal year 1995-1996 budget on the Agenda. Commissioner Middleton had ask that the Hwy 411 project route be added to the agenda on Monday, June 26. Mayor Cass stated that he had the Assistant Recorder to check with MTAS to make sure that this was legal. MTAS' Sid Hemsley advised that the Town stay with the original agenda. City Attorney Jeri Bryant also made the same recommendation. Therefore, Mayor Cass recommended that the Board consider only what was already on the agenda.

Commissioner Middleton stated that he felt that Mayor Cass was playing games. That the Mayor had not tried to contact him about this. He stated that he had been on the Board previously and that 24 hour notice was not a violation of the sunshine law.

Wayne Williams asked Mayor Cass, "Are you refusing to listen to us?"

Mayor Cass stated, "Yes."

Motion was made by Brock, seconded by Middleton to accept on third reading the fiscal year 1995-1996 budget. Davis-Aye, Long-Nay, Brock-Aye, Middleton-Aye.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Davis to adjourn the meeting. All ayes.
