1&I SEWER UPDATE

Joe Cline addressed the Board about where the city stands on our I&I Sewer problems. He spoke of the letter that he sent to the Chattanooga Field Office Manager Division of Water Resource, which explained that we have had no overflows for the past three months and that 76 of the 113 defect letters have been fixed by the customers. Commissioner Phillips asked Cline how long we have to stay under the moratorium, Cline told Phillips that we have to go 12 months with no overflows.
